

INSTALLATION

The covers should be mounted to a fence, balcony railing or other stable supporting structure. The height of the fence guard should not exceed 10 cm. If the guard extends too far, it may be damaged by wind or other factors.

Use appropriate fasteners or cable ties to secure the cover. Do not overtighten the cable ties or fasteners, as this may damage the cover.

SHORTENING THE FENCE COVER

Before starting shortening, read the instructions carefully and follow all points while performing the operation.

ATTENTION!

If the threads are not glued before shortening (height and width), the strips will not be secured and the mat may fall apart.

IN WIDTH:

STEP 1

Before the separation point and on the next 5 strips, glue the mat with transparent glue (e.g. super glue).



Make sure the glue is dry before cutting.

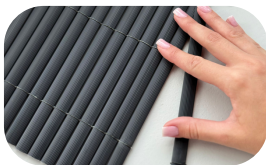
STEP 2

Cut the thread 3-4 strips before the planned cutting point, between the strips.



STEP 3

Remove excess strips.



STEP 4

Tie the protruding threads at least twice.



AT HEIGHT:

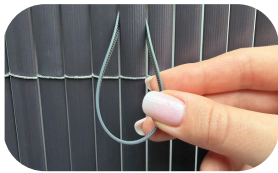
Only the top and bottom threads of the fence guard are fully glued to the strips. If you want to shorten the guard's height, the remaining top thread should be glued to the strips on both sides across their entire width. Use clear glue as described above. Once the glue has dried, the strips can be shortened.

SAFE INSTALLATION:

You can use one of two installation methods: a mounting kit or cable ties.
